NOTICE OF RACE

The notation [NP] in a rule in the NOR or SIs means it shall not be grounds for protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation [DP] in a rule in the NOR or SIs means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the jury, be less than disqualification.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HYRC is proud to host the 2026 Hood River One Design (HR1D) regatta in the Cascade Locks area of the Columbia River. This sailing site is world-renowned for its breeze and scenery. This year the HR1D will be sailed out of the Columbia Gorge Racing Association (CGRA) site [located at the Cascade Locks Marine Park](#) on the north side of the small marine basin. **Note: Please park both trailers and vehicles in the CGRA parking area as all other parking is paid and the Sternwheeler lot is restricted to their customers.**

Social: A fleet gathering is planned for Friday night at a Cascade Locks pub (TBD) after the practice race. Saturday dinner and drinks, August 1, will be held at the Skamania Coves Resort in Stevenson, WA on the patio overlooking the Columbia River. **Dinner tickets are purchased separately** as we are sharing the evening with the Tasar and Laser fleets who are hosting their own regatta at Skamania Coves. <https://theclubspot.com/shop/regatta/jjaYKxJ0Xh/merchandise>

2026 HOOD RIVER ONE DESIGN - NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by The Racing Rules of Sailing, and the local fleet rules for each of the one design classes.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix V1 AND V2, Alternative Penalties apply.
- 1.3. RRS 56.2 is deleted. [A boat shall comply with rule 10, Traffic Separation Schemes, of the IRPCAS]
- 1.4. Competitors shall carry a functioning outboard engine meeting Class Rule C.5.3 (minimum 2.5 HP, gas or electric, and minimum empty weight of 12 kg). This is for your safety and the safety of our volunteers on the course.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The sailing instructions will be available no later than July 31, 2026.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The online official notice board is located at the event website.
- 3.2. [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The event is open to J/70s.
- 4.2. Eligible boats may enter by registering online at the event website.
- 4.3. All registration fees are non-refundable on or after July 31, 2026.

5. FEES

- 5.1. Entry fee: \$250 per boat. Register at <https://scoreyc.com/regatta/8K6pqRgZXBl>
- 5.2. Saturday Dinner at the Skamania Coves resort (alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks included) tickets are \$35 per person. Purchase at <https://theclubspot.com/shop/regatta/jjaYKxJOXh/merchandise> right after you register for the regatta.
- 5.3. Moorage is free on the Cascade Locks Marina Transient dock for stays under 72 hours.

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7. RACING AREAS

- 7.1. Addendum A 'Racing Area' shows the location of the racing area.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. One (1) race will constitute a series.
- 8.2. Scoring shall be according to the Low Point Scoring System of RRS A2 and A4 as follows:
- 8.2.1. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores;
- 8.2.2. When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.3. RRS 90.3(e) applies.
- 8.4. The time limit of 90 minutes is the maximum allowable time from a boat's starting signal to her finishing time or a time of day. A boat that does not finish within the time limit will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes RRS 35.
- 8.5. A boat scored OCS, NSC, DNF, RET, DSQ, DNE, UFD, or BFD shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats starting, sailing the course, and finishing and not retiring or being disqualified. A boat scored DNC or DNS shall be scored points for the finishing place two more than the number of boats starting, sailing the course, and finishing and not retiring or being disqualified. This changes RRS A5.2.

9. LAUNCHING & BERTHING

- 9.1. Launching is limited to ramp entry and is available both in the Ports of Cascade Locks and Port of Skamania. Trailer storage is provided in CGRA grass parking area in the Marina Park just east of the Sternwheeler visitor parking lot. Please reach out to one of the regatta Co-chairs if you need longer-term storage for your trailer/boat in the Gorge prior to or after the event.
- 9.2. Moorage: Overnight moorage will be located in the Cascade Locks Marina on the transient dock with overflow on the CGRA docks. See map above.
- 9.3. Storage of any sailing equipment or boat gear is not permitted on any docks including soft dock boxes.
- 9.4. **Please park both trailers and vehicles in the CGRA parking area (see map) as all other parking is paid and the Sternwheeler lot is restricted to their customers.**

10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS [DP]

- 10.1. Boats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers.

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12. RRS 3 - RISKS

- 12.1. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes. Consequently, the race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, technical committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME, LIKENESS, AND PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 13.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio, and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
- 13.2. Additionally, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and race officials the right to use their personal contact information, including but not limited to a current email address and cell phone number, for the purpose of race administration and regatta communications.
